Sign up for the Feeder Pig Lottery!

What is it?

The Feeder Pig Lottery helps 4-Hers find high quality hogs at a lower price than may be available to them otherwise. The price paid will be closely based on the current market price at the time of the lottery.

When does it start?

The Lottery will take place on April 19, 2008. The registration deadline is March 15.

What do I have to do?

- Take complete ownership of the hog after the lottery.
- Provide housing, feed and care for the hogs you receive. (There is help in finding housing! Ask Dennis!)
- Show your hogs at the Seward County Fair.

How do I sign up?

Contact the Extension Office **before March 15th** with your name, address, phone number and the number of pigs you would like to be in the lottery for (Maximum of 4).

Feeder Pig Lottery Questions...

What if I don't have a place to put the hogs, but I still want to participate?

Help is available in finding housing. Call the Extension Office for more information.

Do I have to show the hogs at the fair?

We would like you to do that. However, if the hogs are under weight other arrangements will be made. If this is an issue, please call the Extension Office.

If I sign up for four will I get that many?

Yes! However, many hogs you sign up for is how many you will receive. The reason we say it is a lottery refers to **how** the hogs are selected for the 4-H'er.

The deadline for sign up is March 15th!
