Security Cameras and Buzzer System

Beginning on Monday, November 26, the only doors that will be unlocked before school are the main doors on the south side of the building and the handicap doors on the east side (science hallway). These are the only two doors installed with a buzzer system. All students and visitors are asked to use these two entrances.

After 8:15am, all doors will be locked during the school day. Everyone, students and adults alike, will need to use one of the two doors installed with a buzzer to gain access to the building. Please push the button and one of the office staff will release the lock. You may be asked to identify yourself prior to entering.
