SOCIAL WORKER

Earnings: Photographers get paid about \$18,380.

Photographers make and save images that paint and tell a story of someone's life. Or it just might record an event. Most photographers use digital cameras.

JOB OUTLOOK: Photographers job can increase in some parts and other parts will decrease.

EARRINGS: The top 10% earned between \$67,490 – 76,100. Secondary school teachers earn from 43,580 to 48,690 in may 2006. The lowest 10 percent earned 67,490 to 76,100. Median earnings for preschool teachers were 22,680.

JOB OUTLOOK: The job outlook is supposed to grow faster than average. But it will differ from good or bad because of the location, grade level and the subject taught.
